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PART I - TERMS OF REFERENCE

FOR A CONSULTANT PERFORMING elaboration of submission on Monitoring of the implementation of the recommendation CM/REC (2010)5 of the committee of ministers to member states on measures to combat discrimination on grounds of sexual orientation or gender identity.

A. DELIVERABLES

The objective of this consultancy is to provide services related to the monitoring of the implementation of the Committee of Ministers' Recommendation CM/REC (2010)5 on measures to combat discrimination on grounds of sexual orientation or gender identity. The consultant will play a key role in gathering information from our member organisations, conducting research, analysing relevant data, and proposing a strategic framework for assessing member states' adherence to the Recommendation and supporting member organisations in engaging with their governments and public authorities.

The consultant will have to:

- 1. Provide a detailed work plan of the project, including a timeline for the deliverables in line with the proposed timeline of the project.
- 2. Elaborate, in accordance with EL*C, a plan of engagement of EL*C members with national and local authorities during the review process.
- 3. Propose a detailed plan for the collection of information on the list of practices and the list of case studies. The detailed plan shall include the methodological approach chosen
- 4. On the basis of the plan developed under deliverable 2, coordinate and support EL*C members actions toward national and local authorities
- 5. Define, in accordance with EL*C, the list of practices and the list of case studies from the members.
- 6. Collect the data on the basis of the data collection plan developed under Deliverable 3.
- Draft the submission on Monitoring of the implementation of the recommendation CM/REC (2010)5 of the committee of ministers to member states on measures to combat discrimination on grounds of sexual orientation or gender identity.

D. ASSESSMENT

Exclusion criteria

Tenderers shall be excluded from participating in the tender procedure if they:

- have been sentenced by final judgement on one or more of the following charges: participation in a criminal organisation, corruption, fraud, money laundering;
- are in a situation of bankruptcy, liquidation, termination of activity, insolvency or arrangement with creditors or any like situation arising from a procedure of the same kind, or are subject to a procedure of the same kind;
- have received a judgement with res judicata force, finding an offence that affects their professional integrity or serious professional misconduct;

- do not comply with their obligations as regards payment of social security contributions, taxes and dues, according to the statutory provisions of their country of incorporation, establishment or residence;
- are or are likely to be in a situation of conflict of interests;
- have been accused of practising discriminatory or derogatory acts towards the LGBTI community;
- have been accused of human rights violations of any kind;

Eligibility criteria

The consultant shall demonstrate that they fulfil the following criteria (to be assessed on the basis of all supporting documents listed in Section E):

- Demonstrated experience in conducting research on human rights standards, gender equality policies or LGBTI rights at national, European and international levels.
- Experience working on the previous review of the CM Rec 2010(5) at national or European level is an advantage.
- Excellent data analysis skills, especially in analysis of legal text, policy and practices by public authorities.
- Demonstrated intersectional feminist background.
- Volunteer or working experience within the LBTI movement
- Good understanding of current and past struggles of LBTI women and non-binary persons.
- Strong organisational, interpersonal, and project management skills.
- Sense of initiative and ability to be self-supporting, including ability to deliver under pressure and within tight deadlines.
- Excellent drafting skills and ability to render complex, technical and/or legal terminology understandable and communicable.
- Excellent English and excellent knowledge of another EU language.
- Good knowledge of additional EU languages is a strong asset.
