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PART I - TERMS OF REFERENCE

FOR A CONSULTANT OR A COMPANY PERFORMING MASS MEDIA ANALYSIS OF PRESS CLIPPINGS

A. DELIVERABLES

The subject of this procurement is the analysis of lesbian representation in Europe and Central Asia through analysis of mass media (press clippings). The research will be conducted by considering the provided press clippings sourced by EL*C through a third party press clipping service with a possibility for additional methods proposed by the consultant(s). This analysis will focus on identifying trends in representation of lesbians, how this representation is done, also how it can be improved.

From the desk research, the researcher(s) will select and examine in depth a collection of press clippings, specifically focusing on the representation of lesbians in the media, starting from the available research on the subject. The aim is to identify instances where such representation is either neutral, positive (empowering) or negative (perpetuates stereotypes and discrimination). In alignment with the research objectives, the researcher(s) will also compile a set of case studies drawn from these press clippings to assess the overall impact of media portrayal on the lesbian community. This analysis will provide insights into the state of lesbian representation in media across the selected range of countries in Europe and Central Asia and media outlets.

The consultant will have to:

- 1. Provide a detailed workplan of the project, including a timeline for the deliverables in line with the proposed timeline of the project.
- 2. Desk Research: This analysis aims to shed light on how lesbians are portrayed in mass media and what sort of journalistic practices prevail. The research will also examine available studies on representation of lesbians in the media, also focusing on the aspect of intersectionality of lesbian representation, examining how factors such as race, class, national-cultural differences, gender, etc. impact the media portrayal of lesbians.
- 3. Define, in accordance with EL*C, the methodologies of research. Propose a detailed plan for the sampling of information on the list of press clippings (sampling methodology), and methodological approach chosen for analysis (multi-methodological approaches including systematic review and coding of selected press clippings).
- 4. Implement the sampling plan and develop research question and structure of research.

- 5. Conduct a mass media analysis on selected press clippings sample (the press clippings will be provided by the EL*C), with a particular emphasis on the portrayal of lesbians in media.
- 6. Draft preliminary results report by 15 November 2023.
- 7. Finalize the research report in time for publication on the 15 December 2023.

D. ASSESSMENT

Exclusion criteria

Tenderers shall be excluded from participating in the tender procedure if they:

- have been sentenced by final judgment on one or more of the following charges: participation in a criminal organisation, corruption, fraud, money laundering;
- are in a situation of bankruptcy, liquidation, termination of activity, insolvency or arrangement with creditors or any like situation arising from a procedure of the same kind, or are subject to a procedure of the same kind;
- have received a judgment with res judicata force, finding an offence that affects their professional integrity or serious professional misconduct;
- do not comply with their obligations as regards payment of social security contributions, taxes and dues, according to the statutory provisions of their country of incorporation, establishment or residence;
- are or are likely to be in a situation of conflict of interests;
- have been accused of practicing discriminatory or derogatory acts towards the LGBTI community;
- have been accused of human rights violations of any kind;

Eligibility criteria

The consultant shall demonstrate that they fulfill the following criteria (to be assessed on the basis of all supporting documents listed in Section E):

- Demonstrated experience in conducting research on media representation, specifically focusing on gender, sexual orientation, or lesbian representation at national, European, Central Asian and international levels.
- Demonstrated strong skills in media content analysis, particularly in analyzing themes, stereotypes, and representations found in press clippings, articles, or other forms of mass media.
- Demonstrated feminist background, with a focus on how different social and identity categories intersect within media practices.
- Solid understanding of current and historical trends related to lesbian representation in media, as well as awareness of the broader challenges facing LBTI women and non-binary persons.
- Strong organizational, interpersonal, and project management skills.
- Sense of initiative and ability to be self-supporting, including ability to deliver under pressure and within tight deadlines.
- Excellent drafting skills and ability to render complex theoretical or methodological concepts understandable and communicable.

- Excellent English and excellent knowledge of another EU language.
- Good knowledge of an additional EU languages is a strong asset.
